Noble Cavalry and Heavy Cavalry : Similar to their ostrogothic counterpart, they wear armour and a shield. Their main weapon was the kontarion, a shorter version of the kontos, although the kontos was a possible armament.

Transylvanian Heavy Cavalry: Although having the same equipment of Noble Cavalry, although somewhat cheaper, the lack of élan made their charge less powerful, hence the lack of shock status.

Huns: As Gepids were vassals of Huns, they were able to field a unit of hunnic light cavalry. Some may have been assimilated in the gepid army.

Warriors and Transylvanian Elite Warriors: Those were the heaviest form of the gothic warriors. They carried a big and heavy shield and fought in a square formation. They fought with spear and sword and some other hast weapons. They were more than a match for many other warriors, except Frankish warriors, and even then, if caught unguard.

Transylvanian Warriors: The mass of gothic warriors, fighting with spear and sword, some having a shield.

Dismounted Cavalry: Sometimes, heavy cavalrymen fought dismounted as a phalanx of heavy spearmen. They carried spears which could be about 3m long.

Archers: They use the short bow, and didn't wear any armour.

Skirmishers : Usual javelinmen, without much protection and fighting in open order.
