**Epirot Phalanx:** Similar in quality as Macedonian phalanxes, the Epirot phalanx is one of the main units of Pyrrhus army.

**Tarantine Phalanx:** Less well drilled than most phalanx, the Tarantine phalanx is nonetheless part of the backbone of that army. Well supported, it can be a threat to any one. This is an upgrade of the epirot phalanx.

**Guard Phalanx:** Part of the Phalangites were of better quality than average, mainly veterans Chaeonians.

**Hoplites:** Regular hoplites but of mediocre quality. Usually either Italiote or Greek allies.

**Galatians:** Celtic people from the Danube area, the Galatians were fierce warriors.

**Oscans:** A valuable light infantry not unlike greek peltasts, although using different equipment.

**Skirmishers:** As can be found in many armies, those skirmishers are armed with javelins, bows and slings. Mostly nondescript archers or slingers, or Italian javelinmen.

**Oscan Cavalry:** Similar to Greek cavalrymen, but now using a shield. May include Thessalian and other Greek cavalrymen.

**Mounted Skirmishers:** The usual mounted javelinmen, mainly Greeks and Tarantine Cavalrymen.

**Elephants:** Of Asian stock, they were greatly feared at first by Romans, as those were the first ones they encountered. Those elephants were also the first ones to carry a howdah, with pikemen inside.

**Epirot Cavalry:** Some elite cavalry was using the lance instead of javelin. This is an upgrade of the Oscan cavalry. Only one such upgrade is possible whatever the size of the army.
